RAC holds a public star party one Saturday night each month. The star party schedule for 2016 is shown below. These star parties are held at Caledon State Park on VA Route 218. The public is invited to come out and enjoy the beauty of the night sky through amateur telescopes. If you're thinking about purchasing a telescope, you also get a chance to look through a variety of telescopes to help you chose the right one. Plan to arrive shortly after sunset and stay as long as telescopes are on the field. A cloudy sky forecast will cancel the star party, so check our website after noon on the same day to confirm that we'll be there and what time sunset is that day.

#### **Education and Outreach**

Education is a primary RAC mission. We hold public outreach events, setting up telescopes at schools and other public locations in the Fredericksburg area for solar observing during the day and lunar and planetary observing at night. ### **Monthly Meetings**

RAC members meet on the third Wednesday of each month, and guests are welcome.
