Star Parties

Most star parties are held at Caledon State Park on VA Route 218 or at other area locations. The public is invited to come out and enjoy the beauty of the night sky through amateur telescopes. Star parties also afford a chance to look through a variety of scopes as an input to choosing the right one. Plan to arrive shortly after sunset and stay as

long as scopes are on the field. A cloudy sky forecast will cancel the star party.

Education and Outreach

Education is a primary RAC mission. RAC conducts public outreach events, setting up telescopes at schools and selected public locations in the Fredericksburg area for solar observing during the day and lunar and planetary observing at night. School lectures are also possible. Monthly Meetings

RAC meets on the second Wednesday of each month and guests are welcome. Meetings open with a program on astronomy topics ranging from scientific advances to astrophotography to how to use a telescope. A business session follows the program.
